## **2023 Terms and Conditions**

- A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to secure a booking.
- The guest who makes the booking for Boonoona Ski Lodge must be a City Tattersalls Club Gold Member. Potential guests can sign up for Gold Membership online and book immediately after.
- The balance of accommodation charges must be paid at least 45 days prior to arrival at Boonoona.
- Boonoona Ski Lodge has 14 rooms and 50 bed licences. There may be a minimum per-person base applied to each room. Single bookings are welcomed; however, a single supplement may be charged.
- Bookings can be made for stays of two, five or seven days only. Guests must arrive and depart on either Friday or Sunday.
- In the event of COVID 19 travel restrictions, guests will receive a credit note to use later in 2023 or in 2024 (2024 season rates will apply. These rates are not yet available).
- Both credits and payments for accommodation at Boonoona are not refundable under any circumstances.
- Travel insurance is highly recommended.
- If City Tattersalls Club needs to cancel the booking for any reason, payments will be refunded in full.
- City Tattersalls Club reserves the right to allocate bookings to any room in the lodge.
- Bookings are not transferable under any circumstances.
- Children under the age of 3 can be accommodated; however, extra fees apply. Guests travelling with babies and toddlers need to bring their own porta cot. There is limited floor space in the rooms.
- Children's rates are for three to twelve-year-olds. They will receive children's meals and may, at the discretion of the lodge manager, be served dinner earlier than the dedicated time for adults. The child's age is taken on the day of arrival.
- Rates include three meals per day. A cooked and continental breakfast is offered. Lunch is a light, buffet-style arrangement. Dinner comprises of an entrée, main and dessert. Dietary requirements can be catered for. Please advise us at least seven days prior to arrival. Please be aware food prepared on site may contain or come into contact with common allergens, such as dairy, eggs, wheat, soybeans, tree nuts, peanuts, fish or shellfish. Tea and coffee are available 24/7.
- Guests must not bring their own alcohol to Boonoona. The lodge is fully licensed.
- Pets or domestic animals are not permitted at Boonoona or within Kosciuszko National Park.
- Low season bookings are subject to demand.
- Over snow transport is only provided if guests arrive after 9am and prior to 6pm on the day of check-in.
- Accommodation rates are dependant on the part of the season.

Low season 9<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> June & 15<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> September

**Shoulder season**  $23^{rd} - 29^{th}$  June &  $8^{th} - 14^{th}$  September

**Peak season** 30<sup>th</sup> June – 7<sup>th</sup> September

- Rooms will be available after 2pm but guests who arrive earlier can leave their bags at Boonoona and spend the day on the slopes.
- Check-out is at 9.30am. Bags can be left at Boonoona and dropped at the Skitube later in the day.
