

## 2025 Boonoona Ski Lodge Terms and Conditions

- Early Bird Bookings: 25% non-refundable deposit is required to secure an early bird booking.
- 1.5% Credit card surcharge
- The remaining 25% of the regular 50% deposit must be paid by 28th February 2025.
- All payments for early bird bookings are non-refundable.
- Regular Bookings: A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to secure a booking.
- All payments, regardless of booking type, are non-refundable.
- The balance of accommodation charges must be paid at least 45 days before arrival at Boonoona.
- Discounts offered throughout the season cannot be applied retrospectively.
- The guest who makes the booking for Boonoona Ski Lodge must be a City Tattersalls Club Gold Member. Potential guests can sign up for Gold Membership online and book immediately after.
- Guests who book via a third-party website such as Booking.com or Expedia will become City Tattersalls Club Gold Members but are NOT eligible to receive the 10% City Tattersalls Club Gold Member discount.
- The 10% City Tattersalls Club Gold Member discount cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer or applied on top of a sale.
- There may be a minimum per-person base applied to each room. Single bookings are welcomed; however, a single supplement will be charged.
- Bookings cannot be cancelled and are not transferable under any circumstances, including unfavourable conditions or lack of snow. Date changes are permitted until 30 days before the scheduled arrival, subject to availability. Please be aware room rates differ throughout the season and additional costs must be paid for.
- In the event of COVID-19 travel restrictions, guests will receive a credit note to use later in 2025 or 2026. If not used in 2025, 2026 rates will apply.
- Both credits and payments for accommodation at Boonoona are non-refundable under any circumstances.
- Travel insurance is highly recommended.
- If City Tattersalls Club needs to cancel the booking, payments will be refunded.
- City Tattersalls Club is not responsible for any decisions made by Vail Resorts, owner and operator of Perisher. If Perisher ceases mountain operations before the forecast end of the season (Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> October 2025) guests will be given a credit note to use in 2026. Credits will expire at the end of the following season; however, a one-year extension can be granted. - City Tattersalls Club reserves the right to allocate bookings to any room in the lodge.
- Children's rates are for three to twelve-year-olds inclusive. They will receive children's meals and may, at the discretion of the lodge manager, be served dinner earlier than the dedicated time for

adults. Kids' meals include a two-course dinner. The child's age is taken on the day of arrival. <u>If a child's rate has been charged and adult meals are requested for the child, an upgrade fee must be paid at the lodge before departure.</u>

- Children aged 13 and over will be served adult meals and charged adult rates.
- Children under the age of three can be accommodated and stay free of charge. Guests travelling with babies and toddlers need to bring their own porta cot and food for them. There is limited floor space in the rooms.
- Guests at Boonoona will enjoy three meals every day. This includes a hot and continental breakfast, a light lunch such as sandwiches, and a three-course dinner. The menu is generally popular Australian cuisine such as a bacon and egg breakfast and meat and vegetable dinner. Kids' meals include a two-course dinner. Rates include three meals per day. A cooked and continental breakfast is offered. A light lunch including sandwiches is provided. Dinner is comprised of an entrée, main, and dessert. Dietary requirements can be catered for. Please notify us at least 14 days before your arrival. Please be aware food prepared on-site may contain or come into contact with common allergens such as dairy, eggs, wheat, soybeans, tree nuts, peanuts, fish or shellfish. Tea and coffeemaking facilities are available 24/7.
- Guests must not bring alcohol to Boonoona. The lodge is fully licensed, and drinks can only be purchased from the in-house bar.
- Pets or domestic animals are not permitted at Boonoona or within Kosciuszko National Park.
- Low season bookings are subject to demand.
- Over-snow transport is only provided if guests arrive after 9:00am and before 5:00pm on the day of check-in. Guests must make their own way to Boonoona if arriving outside these hours. 4Site provides over-snow transport between 7:30 am and 10:00pm.
- Check-in at Boonoona begins at 2:00 PM when rooms become available. Guests arriving earlier are welcome to leave their bags at the lodge and enjoy a day on the slopes.
- Check-out is at 10:00 AM. Guests can leave their bags at Boonoona, and they will be delivered to the Ski tube later in the day.
- Guests can be dropped off at Front Valley in the morning and picked up from the same location in the afternoon. Anyone wishing to return to Boonoona for lunch must make their own way back to the lodge, either by walking or via 4Site.
- Accommodation rates are dependent on the part of the season.
