We have called these people "Legends" because, in the context of our Club, that is exactly what they are.

They are people who have won the respect and admiration of Members and staff alike through their dedication, selfless service and leadership and their contribution should not and will not be quickly forgotten.


The Legend status that they receive tonight will be the highest status our Club can bestow. It will not be an easy status to achieve. 13 people receive it tonight because we are playing catch up. If the special status was recognised years ago, many of those who receive it tonight would have received it 10 or even 20 years ago.



To formalise and recognise their golden status, each will receive a 18ct gold pin (or drop). You can see it on the screen. Note that the horse also has a diamond eye.

These are bespoke pieces, made of pure gold because that is what each one of these recipients have been to our Club.

In addition to the pin (or drop), each legend will receive a special leather-bound copy of our 125th year anniversary book. "On a Winner", and if they turn to the final chapter of that book, they will see that the author (Marea Donnelly) has predicted that tonight will happen, and they will see their names up in lights, as well they should be, in a publication that records the important history of our Club.



They will also receive a gold framed certificate that reads:
